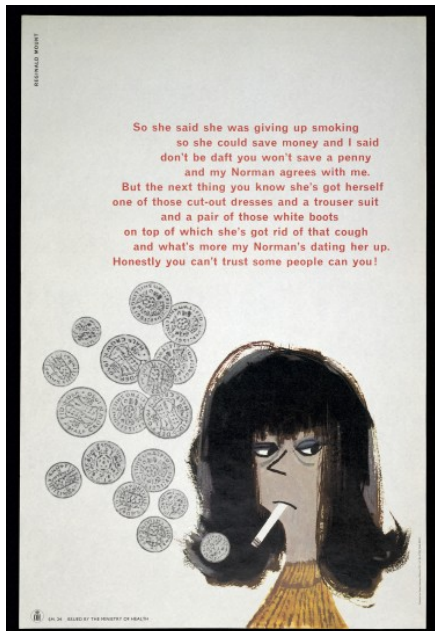


Library items in current exhibitions
